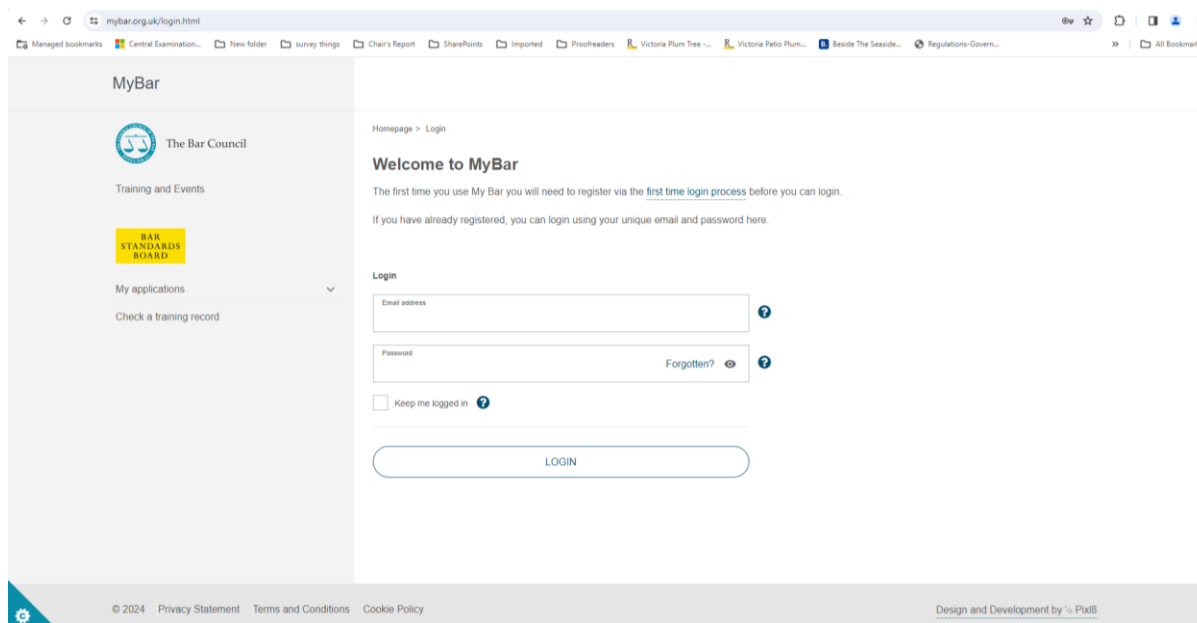


How to Find Your MyBar Unique Identification Number

Step One: Log in to MyBar

1. Go to this website: <https://www.mybar.org.uk/login.html>



2. **If you have logged into MyBar in the past**, enter your log in details. If you have forgotten your password, click “forgotten?” in the password box and follow the password recovery process.
3. **If you have never logged into MyBar**, please begin the first time log in process by clicking this link:

The first time you use My Bar you will need to register via [the first time login process](#) before you can login.

If you have already registered, you can login using your unique email and password here.

4. To complete the first time log in process, you will need to enter the e-mail address to which we sent an e-mail at the beginning of your Bar Training Course inviting you to register for MyBar. This is likely to be your student e-mail address.

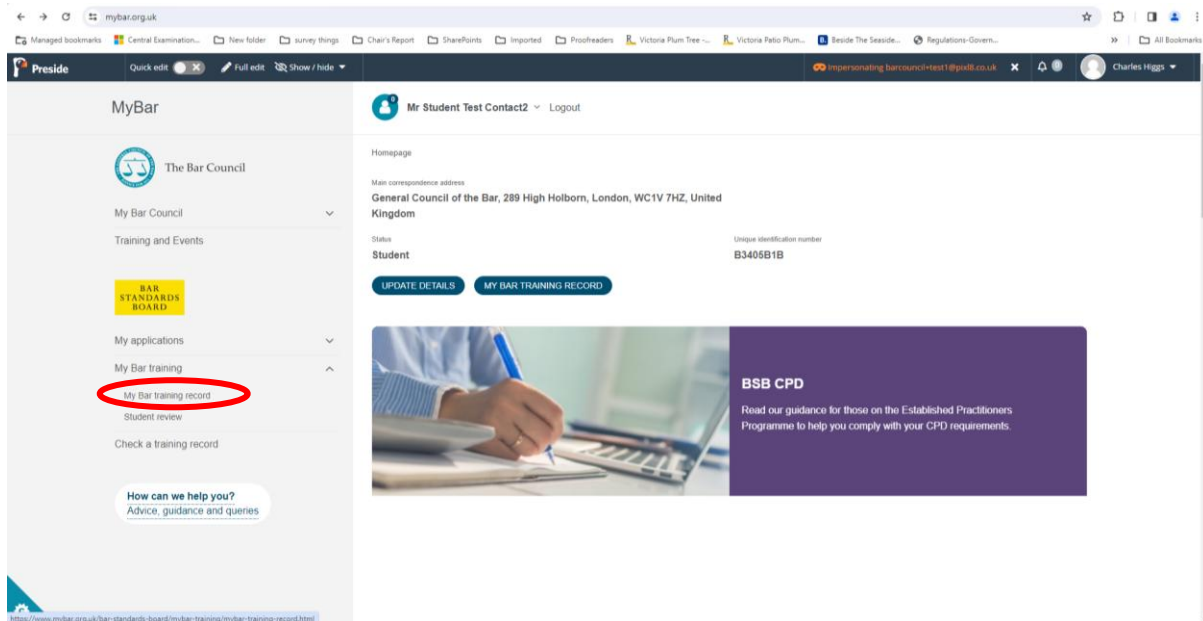

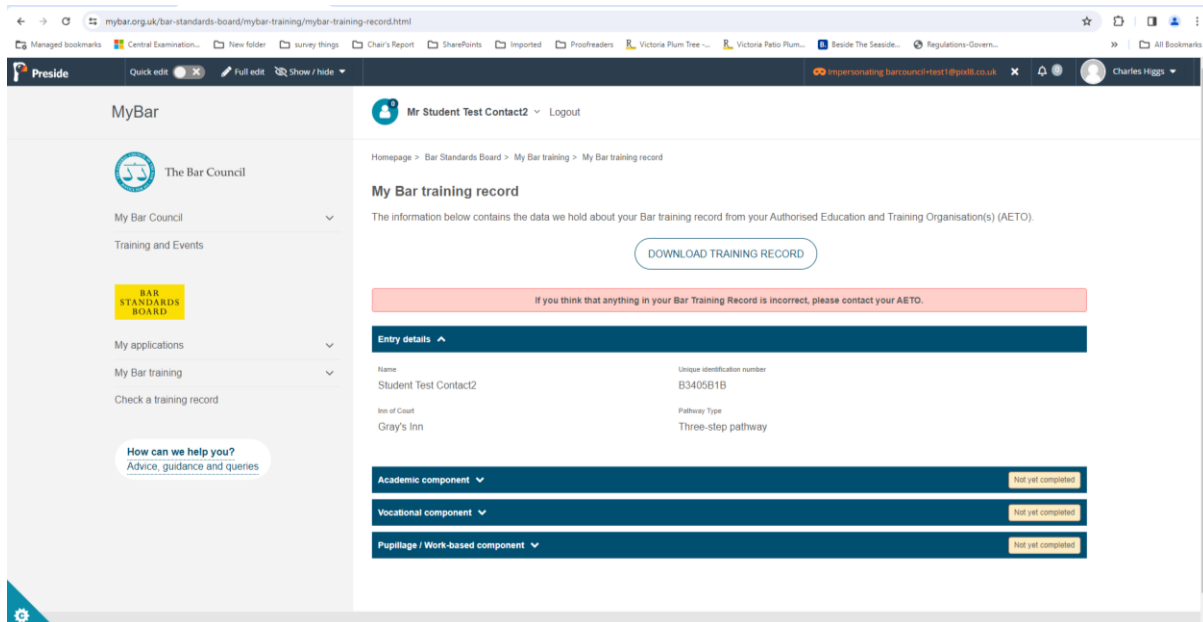
